

The Annual Vivekananda Competition is conducted by the Rama Krishna Mission, New Delhi, every year for students to inculcate in them the idea of Enlightened Citizenship.

Competition is conducted at three levels. All students of class M2 of our school participated in this event. Navya Munjal and Soham Kumar of our school qualified for the second round held at the Mission premises in Delhi. The final result of the competition was declared at an awards ceremony in January 2016. Navya Munjal, a student of Gyan Bharati School emerged second in the junior category among about 8500 students from 144 schools that participated. She has been awarded prize money of Rs. 7500/- and a certificate of excellence for her outstanding performance in the competition.
