1. The Ramakrishna Sharda Mission organized an Elocution and Essay competition, on 25th October, 2017. In the elocution competition,

2. NIE in collaboration with BYJU conducted the National Aptitude Challenge on 26th September, 2017. There were 3 rounds. Round 1 was the school level round wherein it was for 3 categories for 5-6th class, 7-8th class and 9-10th class. The school topper from category 1, Ira of class M1 A won a Wildcraft backpack.

Ishaan Sengupta of S1 B was the winner from the second category and Nandini Motwani of SS1 A was the winner from category 3. They both won tablets in their respective categories.

3. Times SPARK is a scholarship exam under Read to Lead Program conducted by Times of India. SPARK stands for Scholarship Programme for Awareness, Responsibility and Knowledge. The Times of India published an article everyday starting from Sept. 5th for 90 days. At the end, there was an online test, followed by an interview to assess the students' understanding and perspectives. Deekshita Pramod of S1 A secured ranking among the top 25 % participants in this exam for the academic year 2017-18.

Under SPARK, another programme was initiated to promote reading among students of classes 9 to 12. More than 2 lakh students across the country registered for the programme. MuskanArora of SS2 D was awarded a platinum certificate for successfully ranking among the top 10% participants.

Nehal Gupta of SS2 B has emerged as one of the 300 students all over the country, among the 2 lakh students who appeared for the Times SPARK scholarship exam. She has been awarded a cash prize of 1 lakh rupees along with a certificate. The news, along with her photograph was published on 17 March 2018.

4. A painting competition was organized by CGWB, Ministry of Water, Govt. of India. Out of 8500 students who submitted their paintings, 50 were selected for an on-the-spot competition, which was held on 23rd Feb, 2018.
