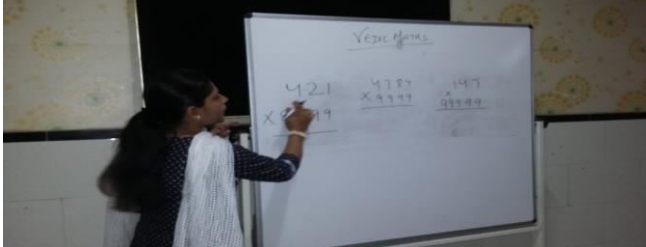


REPORT ON VEDIC MATHEMATICS
